Experience and knowledge are exploited in an international environment helping the young generation take off: initiatives as the “**Rising Stars**” and the “**Future Leaders’ Mentoring Programme**” help young **researchers and clinicians having a chance to boost their career**.

Daring wisely is the challenge of the workshop transforming itself and evolving with the progress of knowledge, practice and tools remaining always open to ideas, new approaches and challenging controversial discussions.
